例句: The sound of the river was a continuous background noise throughout the night.

contrive /k n tra v/ 设法做到;谋划,策划,设计

例句: He contrived a clever plan to surprise his friends on their birthday.

convention /k n v n n/ 大会;协定,公约;惯例,习俗

例句:The annual convention of the association attracted delegates from all over the world.

例句: It's important to criticize constructively rather than destructively.

例句:The government declared a state of emergency due to the natural disaster.

decrease /d kri s/ 减少,减小

例句: The company's profits have decreased significantly over the past year.

deliver /d I v r/ 递送,交付;接生;拯救,解救;发表,表达

例句:The courier delivered the package to the customer's doorstep.

例句: The suspect denied any involvement in the crime.

例句: Their enthusiasm gradually diminished as the project dragged on.

例句:A workplace should be designed to be accessible and not disable employees.

discharge /d s rd / 卸货;准许某人离开,解雇;发射

例句: The patient was discharged from the hospital once they recovered.

discipline / d s pl n/纪律,规定;训练;学科;管教,惩罚

例句: Discipline in the classroom is essential for a productive learning environment.

discount / d ska nt/ 折扣;打折;漠视

例句: The store offers a discount for senior citizens.

discourage /d k r d / 使泄气;(设法)阻止

例句: Don't let failures discourage you from pursuing your goals.

例句:The teacher dismissed the class and allowed the students to go to lunch.

例句: The two countries disputed over the ownership of the island.

例句:The solute dissolved completely in the solvent.

例句: The internet has become a vast domain of information and entertainment.

例句: Many people choose to donate their organs after death to help others.

例句: Economics is the study of how resources are allocated.

例句: They had a chance encounter at the library.

例句: Pollution is endangering the health of the river ecosystem.

enrich / n r t / 使富足;使充实,使丰富

例句: Reading extensively enriches one's vocabulary and knowledge.

例句: The student promptly enrolled in the new course after hearing about it.

entitle / n ta tl/给...取名:给予权利(或资格)

例句: The author entitled her book "The Quest for Truth" to reflect its themes.

essence / esns/本质,实质

例句:The essence of the argument is whether or not the government should intervene in the market.

evacuate / vækjue t/使撤退,撤离,疏散

例句:The authorities ordered the evacuation of the area due to the impending storm.
